

FUWARI

We almost left Fuwari off the list on account of its cost, but we thought we would give you the choice. The price is all down to the combination of essential oils used in each one. In Fuwari we have ylang ylang and cassie petal (one of the mimosa family), devastatingly expensive but absolutely gorgeous. Fuwari is Japanese for lovely, soft, kind, delightful, sweet and beautiful and this bar is all of those things. It's worth every penny.

Ingredients: Sodium Bicarbonate, Cream of Tartar (Tartaric acid), Perfume, Sweet Almond Oil (Prunus dulcis), Red Wax (Speccitt Red Z), Ylang Ylang Oil (Cananga odorata), Magnesium Carbonate, Cassie Absolute (Acacia farnesiana), Rice Vinegar, Vanilla Pod Pieces (Vanilla planifolia), Benzyl Alcohol, Benzyl Salicylate, Eugenol, Geraniol, Isoeugenol, Benzyl Benzoate, Farnesol, Linalool, Coumarin, Hydroxycitronellal.

arOMaCreMe

Aromacreme shot to the top of the best seller list as soon as we let it loose on your armpits. It has the same lovely fragrance as Fuwari, plus the absorbent microfine powders. The difference is that it is whipped up into a cream with shea butter, almond oil and lychee fruit. The texture is a bit like mozzarella. Take a pea-sized amount on your fingertip and smooth it on to your dry armpit. We have fragrance, odour absorption and skin softeners all in one gentle, but effective, somewhat quirky but ultimately brilliant deodorant.

Aromaco's most immediate feature is its patchouli scent. In Chinese and Indian herbal medicine patchouli was used for centuries. It came to Britain in Victorian times when it was used to repel moths and as a scent for Indian ink. It is perfect to use in Aromaco because it is deodorising, astringent and toning. Patchouli is kind to scratched or inflamed skin so it's good to put on after shaving your armpits. You'd be hard pressed to find a better essential oil to put in a deodorant.

arOMaRANT

The Aromarant is one of our original deodorants, the stalwart with a refreshing scent that makes it (and you) smell like spiced lemon tea. Whop them with bicarbonate of soda to neutralise odours, plus astringent fresh lemons, toning witch hazel and a collection of essential oils which are good for getting the microscopic nuisances under control. T'Eo is a very powerful deodorising bar. T'Eo takes on smelly pits with its arsenal of bactericide tea tree, lemongrass, juniperberry and lemon oils and makes them smell good for a change. It's a hard working bar for hard working bodies.
